Today the **Youth Group** will meet for the confirmation service at 16.00. Next week's theme 'Seeking Welfare in Exile' (following Jeremiah 29: 1, 4-7).

It is good our Bishop and our Archdeacon can be with us for regular Sunday worship. Today we welcome the archdeaconry representatives and chaplains of the Eastern Archdeaconry, as well as officers of the diocese. Since late Thursday we have been meeting at the Pauluskirche, while staying at the Magdas Hotel.

Concerning Receiving Holy Communion

The Church of England invites all baptised persons who are baptised and communicant members of churches subscribing to the doctrine of the Holy Trinity to receive Holy Communion. Those who do not wish to receive Communion are invited to come forward for a blessing. The practice of intinction (dipping the bread into the wine) is not permitted as directed by our bishop. If you are uncertain about drinking from the common cup receiving the bread only is acceptable.

The next meeting of the **Reading Group** will be on Wednesday 22 October at 19.00. We are reading *Darkenbloom/Dunkelblum* by Eva Menasse.

The person to be the 106th **Archbishop of Canterbury** has been announced. It is The Rt Revd and Rt Hon Dame Sarah Mullaly, presently the Bishop of London. We will keep Bishop Mullaly in our prayers as she prepares for her new responsibilities.

This afternoon at 16.00 a service of **Confirmation** will be held in the church. Eleven persons are being confirmed. Four will also be baptized. All interested in being baptised, confirmed or received into the Church of England are strongly encouraged to attend the service to gain a better understanding of what it means to be confirmed: to be a full member of the Body of Christ as expressed through the Anglican Tradition.

There will be no **Six O'clock Service** tonight. We meet again for a 'Jazz Inspired' service on 19 October.

Please have a look at the **Six O'clock Service** rota in the church centre and consider signing up for welcoming and reading, providing food and, most importantly, washing the dishes!

The **Coffee Rota** is again up in the church centre. Please consider helping with refreshments after the 10.30 service.
