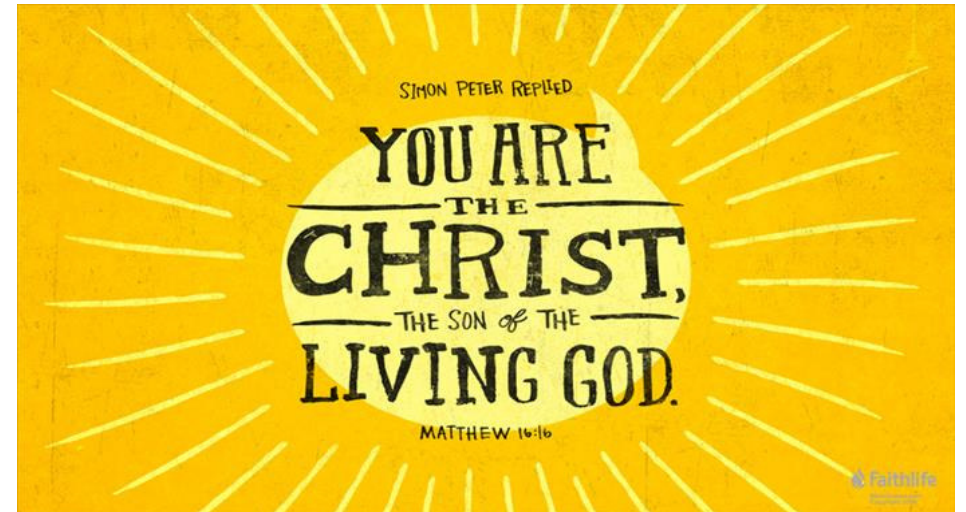

Note the following important information concerning services held in the church building:

- Presently no need to register for any service.
- Please consider joining us at 9.00am, where there is ample room.
- The wearing of masks throughout the whole of any service held in the church building is mandatory.
- Sit at least one metre apart in the pews - places are marked.
- Families and households may sit together.
- Continue to practice social distancing at all times: refrain from shaking hands or embracing upon entering or exiting and during the Peace.
- Coffee in the centre after the 10.00 service is not possible; the centre will only be opened for use of the restrooms and handwashing facilities.

Anyone wishing to receive Holy Communion at home during the pandemic is asked to contact the Chaplain. Please use the church email address.

Currently we are not taking a collection during the services in the church. We ask those of you who would otherwise donate to Christ Church via one of the collection bags to please leave your contribution in the vase at the back of the church after the service and before leaving the church. Your contributions make a difference, and we are thankful for them.

To members of the Electoral Roll:

You can nominate candidates for churchwardens, council members and archdeaconry representatives using the forms that will be displayed in the church garden (not the church porch as in previous years) after every 10.30 Sunday service during August. If you are not coming to 10.30 services at the church, you can ask someone who is attending one of those services to write down your nomination on the relevant form in the garden on your behalf. All nominators and nominees will be contacted before the ACM to confirm, in the case of nominators, their intention to make the nomination and, in the case of nominees, their willingness to serve.

As from 15 August, the electoral roll is closed. If you are not on the electoral roll and would like to apply for membership of the roll for the coming year, you can fill in a form (to be found in the church and centre) and return it to Alexander Rösch, electoral roll officer.
