- Please consider joining us at 9.00am, where there is ample room.
- The wearing of masks throughout the whole of any service held in the church building is mandatory.
- Sit at least one metre apart in the pews - places are marked.
- Families and households may sit together.
- Continue to practice social distancing at all times: refrain from shaking hands or embracing upon entering or exiting and during the Peace.
- Coffee in the centre after the 10.00 service is not possible; the centre will only be opened for use of the restrooms and handwashing facilities.

We ask those of you who would otherwise donate to Christ Church via one of the collection bags to please leave your contribution in the vase at the back of the church after the service and before leaving the church. Zoom study morning: Creationtide (19 Sept): A morning workshop consisting of two sessions 10.00-11.00 (coffee break) and 11.30-12.30, led by Dr Clare Amos. Drawing on both the Old Testament and the New Testament this study morning will explore what the Bible has to say about the relationship between human beings and the rest of creation, which is increasingly seen as one of the most significant issues for our time. It will suggest that our relationship to creation is absolutely integral to our Christian faith. Until her retirement in 2018 Clare Amos worked at the World Council of Churches, Geneva. Clare is passionate about sharing her enthusiasm for the Bible with a wide range of people, and has considerable experience in leading Bible studies. She is the honorary Director of Lay Discipleship for the Diocese in Europe.
