Holy Communion from the Common Cup

The common cup has been restored symbolizing our unity in Christ. Note this is the **common cup**. Intinction (*dipping the bread into the wine*) is **NOT permitted for hygienic reasons and as directed by our bishops**. If you feel uncertain about drinking from the chalice, continuing to receive the bread only is acceptable. Remain kneeling until the wine has passed. Should you have an active respiratory infection of any sort, we ask that you exercise caution and refrain from the cup.

The Homecoming Weekend was well received. There were three highlights: **AfricaNight**, **Kids' Church Olympics** (becoming inter-generational Olympics) and the **Jazz inspired Six O'clock service followed by a Young Adults' social** in the church centre after the service. A big thank you to all who were involved. It was an encouraging weekend.
